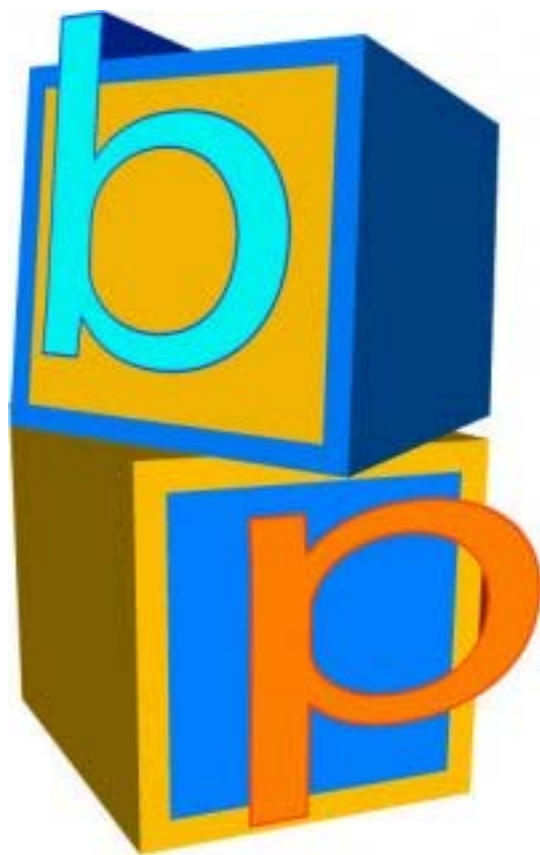

THE BERKELEY PROJECT

AN INTRODUCTION

What is the Berkeley Project?

Started by students for students, the Berkeley Project organizes large community service events where Cal students unite with City residents to fulfill the pressing needs of the community. This year on October 27th, 1500 students and community volunteers will work on approximately 60 projects all around the City of Berkeley and parts of Oakland. Projects range from painting and construction to packing medical supplies and fire prevention (see Project List on the last page for details).

What is the goal of the Berkeley Project?

Our mission is twofold. First, we want to bridge the gap between the campus and the community by creating strong, sustainable partnerships through events and programs such as the Berkeley Project Day and Berkeley Project Month. Secondly, we want to inspire a culture of service and action among students by making Berkeley Project programs fun, productive, and rewarding.

Why should you get involved?

Support the community you live in and create change while working alongside your peers and neighbors. Free breakfast. Free lunch. Free dinner and after party with live music, great raffle prizes, and a free T-shirt! Be part of the movement that started last year with 1000 students and that will continue to grow for years to come.

- 3) Site Leader – After training and a site orientation, be in charge of a volunteer project.
